



Citizen's Bank Nashua A Construction Management Project

One of the most interesting construction management projects involved the building of a new Citizen's branch bank at 238 Main Street in Nashua, New Hampshire.

Complete with a sixty-foot clock tower, the 9,000 square-foot building features Citizen's new, upscale design that includes decorative casework, specialty masonry products, bright colors and varied finishes. This new concept, which Citizen's refers to as the New In-Branch Citizens Experience (N.I.C.E.), gives the facility a very different look and feel from the typical branch bank.



The original branch remained open-for-business throughout the construction process, as Brookstone Builders is well experienced at maintaining the safety, noise, and dust-control standards that are necessary to facilitate such on-site customer traffic. Once the new building was complete and operational, we also dismantled the old branch bank while initiating extensive landscaping and site work.
