This project involved the construction of a new

11,000 square foot state-of-the-art Medical & Training Center for the NH Air National Guard in Newington NH.

The new facility is equipped with full medical and dental wings, security systems, fiber-optic communications and an extremely efficient direct-digital-control heating and cooling systems that can be monitored and controlled by an on-site or remote basis.

The building also contains two dedicated training rooms, and was designed for both administrative services and patient care purposes.

“The added space and efficient design will allow us to provide more effective war-task training,” Medical Squadron **Commander LTC Leroy Dunkelberger** said. “It will also facilitate a more productive sharing arrangement with the Veteran’s Administration, as seacoast area veterans will no longer need to travel to Manchester for medical care.”

Groundbreaking took place in the fall of 2001, and several of the original plans were modified as a result of the 9-11 terrorist attacks. Communications,

security systems and window fabrications were re-designed, and some substantial modifications were made to the site layout and parking areas as well. Base Architect **Mori Mitsui** kept the design information between Government Officials, the Architect, Engineers of record and Brookstone Builders flowing well, and as a result, the project was completed on time.
